**ORDERED**





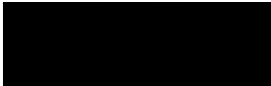
